1. What does Job miss the most about his "months gone by," and what was the primary source of his joy during that time? (29:1-6)
2. How did community leaders and elders respond when Job arrived at the city gate? What does this reveal about his character? (29:7-11)
3. What specific actions did Job take to earn the title of "father to the needy"? (Job 29:12-17)
4. What mistake does Job admit he made regarding his future (Job 29:18-20), and what does this teach us about putting our trust in present prosperity?
5. What sort of people are Job's tormentors in 30:1-10 and what does their mockery indicate about the extent of Job's fall from favor?
6. What does Job mean when he says God has "cast me into the mire"? (30:19)
7. How does Job describe God's response to his prayers and what is his mindset? (30:29-31)
8. What is a key takeaway or reflection from Chapter 30?
9. What does Job declare in Chapter 31?
10. Job denies hiding his transgressions or fearing the judgment of the crowd. How does the temptation to hide our sins affect our spiritual lives, and how does Job's approach contrast with this?
